Early life Nedazob was born Willie C. Harris, in 1944, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Career Harlem In 1965, Nedazob became the lead singer for the gospel group The Grateful Dead. In the mid-1970s, Nedazob was replaced by Harvey Mason. Harvey and Nedazob performed with The Grateful Dead for 9 years; from 1970 to 1979. The two were replaced by Vocalists Vince Welnick and Terrapin Mark after the departure of Harvey Mason from the group. It was the longest and most successful tenure for The Grateful Dead. Musical influence Nedazob was influenced by music. He created his own musical style. He was an afro-saxophonist, who harmonized with the Grateful Dead's pianist, Bruce Hornsby, and they were the two lead vocalists for the Grateful Dead for a brief time. Death Nedazob died on May 28, 2007, in San Diego, California. Recording production Nedazob was the producer for the Grammy awarded album, Dead Ahead by the band, The Grateful Dead.
